Rep. Rick Larsen's Biggest Primary Threat This Year Isn't a Republican – It's Another Democrat

Democratic Representative Rick Larsen's biggest primary threat in 2022 isn't a Republican – it's another Democrat – and he's raising serious money and racking up local endorsements.

Jason Call, a lifelong progressive activist and former public high school teacher, has raised over \$150,000 and recently passed the 10,000 door milestone – more than twice that of the incumbent.

While Larsen has campaigned against Republicans in the past, this may be the first time he will face another Democrat in a general election. "In over 20 years, Rick has never experienced a threat like this before," Call said, "and I don't think he's prepared for a progressive opponent that has the momentum and grassroots excitement like we have. We just finished our best fundraising month ever."

Jason Call has earned the endorsement from most of the Democratic Local Party Organizations in the Second Congressional District including Skagit County Democrats, Democrats from the 44th, 40th, 39th, and 21st legislative districts as well as *sole endorsements* from San Juan County Democrats and the Island County Democrats.

"Door after door we have people telling us they're ready for change," Call said, "we have to demand better from our government, and I'm ready to fight like hell for it."

"It is time for a course correction, and Jason Call is right on all these issues and more," wrote David Turnoy, Chair of San Juan Island Democrats, "One of the reasons Jason is able to stand for what the people want is because he doesn't accept any PAC or corporate contributions."
