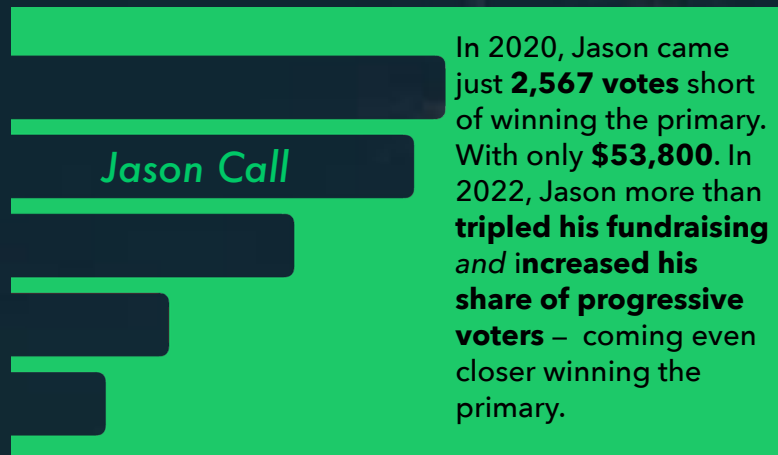
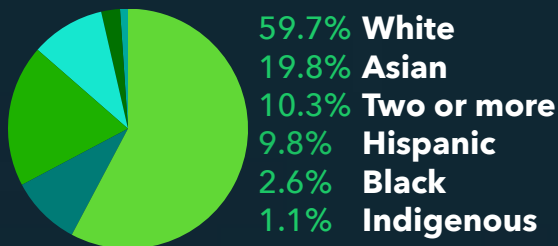
400+ islands Island and San Juan counties are home to over 400 islands. This unique geography hosts the second-largest vehicular ferry system in the world, and the largest in the U.S.



The Second Congressional District is home to about 770,000 people*. According to 2010 Census data, **most people work in education, healthcare, or social services** (21%). About another quarter work in either manufacturing or retail services. As of 2010, **55% do not have a college degree** and over a third (38%) are renters.

Our largest cities are **Everett, Bellingham, Marysville, Lynnwood,** and **Oak Harbor.**

We are home to **Western Washington University** (Bellingham) and a **Washington State University** campus in Everett along with many great community colleges and trade schools.



In 2020, Jason came just **2,567 votes** short of winning the primary. With only **\$53,800**. In 2022, Jason more than **tripled his fundraising and increased his share of progressive voters** – coming even closer winning the primary.

Meet Jason

Jason Call is an **executive board member of Whole Washington**, a volunteer-led effort dedicated to achieving a single-payer healthcare system in Washington state in absence of federal Medicare for All. Jason is also on the staff of Marianne Williamson's 2024 Presidential campaign, serving as the National Volunteer Coordinator and on the Policy Team.

Prior to becoming a Green Party member, Jason was elected to a four-year term on the **Central Committee of the Washington State Democrats** representing both Snohomish County and his local 44th Legislative District. While on the State Committee, Jason **led the 2018 Snohomish County Democratic Party Platform Team** to create the most progressive platform the county had ever adopted. Adapting his leadership experience from the county-level, Jason was instrumental in writing and passing a similar platform for Washington State Democrats along with additional progressive resolutions.

In his personal life, Jason is married to his wife, Shannon, who is finishing her radiation therapy program at Bellevue College. He is an avid soccer and wrestling dad who loves supporting his kids with their academic and athletic ambitions. A musician, Jason is a veteran bass guitar player of over 30 years.

We need a **Federal Jobs Guarantee** now. And the plain truth is that the incumbent does not stand for these things. **I will.**”



Why we must bring change to Congress

Rick Larsen has represented the Second District for over twenty years. In that time, he has accepted millions of dollars from corporate political action committees ranging from **Goldman Sachs** to **Exxon Mobil**. Indeed, no corporate donor is off-limits to Larsen, as he's taken money from fossil fuel corporations, Wall Street banks, and union-busting companies like **Amazon** and **Wal-Mart**.

He even took \$15,000 from the Koch Brothers.

It is beyond time to replace Rick Larsen because policies that center corporate power cannot confront the cascading crises that face working people and our planet.
